	A discussion took place on the proposal to extend the lifespan of the NP from2033 (in line with the Local Plan) to 2038 as suggested by BDC. It was concludedthat it may be better to stay at 2033 as we can then clearly align with BDC instating that no further large developments (10+ houses) are required in EarlsColne to meet the requirements of the emerging BDC Local Plan and the NP.More importantly, Jan Stobart suggested that if we were to extend the NP to2038 we might be required by the NP Inspectorate to provide allocated sites tomeet the estimated housing target suggested by BDC for the period 2034 to2038 (21 units per year). This would require a call for sites, assessment of allsuggestions received and feasibility studies of the most favourable sites whichwould severely delay publication of our NP.However, if we take the above approach, we can add an annex to the NPoutlining longer term visions such as the relief road, a Community LedDevelopment and housing targets beyond 2033 but these can be in the form of	
	suggested "further studies" and would not initially need to be detailed proposals. These "studies" could still be progressed now as specific projects but in parallel with the NP rather than as a commitment within it.
